Questions and Answers:

- **12/14/23 Question:** In the excel document tab "Product & Services Pricing" There is a column for fixed price. What is the expected intent of this section?
- **12/14/23** Mohave Answer: The direction for this worksheet allows for the bidder to submit Percent Off MSRP and Fixed pricing. If your firm's intent is to bid Percent Off MSRP you will complete columns E and F, G includes a formula. If your firm's intent to bid Fixed pricing, you will complete column I. The unused columns can be let blank or deleted. Your firm can also submit manufacturer catalogs or pricelists instead or in conjunction with the worksheet. Review Tab 3 Pricing Workbook Instructions.
- **12/14/23 Question:** With pricing if the manufacturers increase the price on us is there a way to modify the pricing?
- 12/14/23 Mohave Answer: Review Special Term and Condition 11. Pricing to better under what is expected. Also, review Special Term and Condition 11.10 New Catalogs / Price Lists, if you firm bid percent off MSRP, you are able to submit new catalog pricing or pricelist as necessary. For fixed Pricing bids review Special Term and Condition 11.5. Fixed Prices for specifics.
- 12/21/23 Question: Would a self-bond be acceptable for the bid bond?
- **12/21/23** Mohave Answer: Please review Special Term and Condition 2.1. Bid Bond and the Instructions to Bidder and Checklist Form. If you cannot provide a formalized bid bond then alternate bid security can be used.
